The **Board of Trustees** has the care and custody of the property of the church, both real and financial and provides leadership in managing these properties to best support the needs and programs of the church.

The **Board of Deacons** (Diaconate) has general oversight of the spiritual activities of the Church and over the outreach activities within the Parish.

The **Nominating Committee** nominates all Officers and Standing Committee members. It promotes the most effective use of human resources within the Church through consultation with the Minister(s), Officers, Committees, and the membership at large. It endeavors to nominate persons within the Church who, because of their interests, experience, and commitment to the life of the Church, are qualified and willing to accept the responsibility.

The **Stewardship Committee** is responsible for encouraging a climate of generosity and giving and for planning and implementing the annual pledge campaign.

The **Board of Christian Service** brings Christian witness to life by identifying areas of need beyond the congregation and disbursing funds and by organizing volunteer projects to address these needs. It educates and motivates the congregation to support the missions and other benevolent works of the Church.

The **Church School Committee** is responsible for planning and implementing a program to provide religious education for the children of the Church through grade 7.

The **Adult Education Committee** is responsible for developing programs which provide opportunities for adults to grow in their understanding of Christianity and its implications to our lives.

The **Music Committee** is responsible for planning and implementing a program for the performance of music in support of worship services and life rites.

The **Membership Committee** promotes growth and assimilation of the Church membership. It helps assure hospitality and orientation for new members.

The **Youth Fellowship Committee** is responsible for the direction of the Youth Fellowship Groups.

The **Fellowship and Funding Committee** plans special events such as picnics, dinners, trips, and other such events in order to enhance the fellowship and funding potential of the Church.

The main purpose of the **Pastor-Parish Relations Committee** is to support and maintain an accessible, communicative relationship between the Minister(s) and members and groups of the congregation.

The **Flower Committee** provides flowers in the sanctuary for all regular worship services.

The **Hospitality Committee** provides support for special events that require a reception.

The **Association and Conference Delegates** represent or assure the representation of the Church at Association and Conference meetings.
