#### FIRST LESSON

Numbers 11:24-30 Read by Kathleen Jasaitis

So Moses went and told the people what God had said. He gathered seventy elders and had them surround the Tent. The Lord came down in a cloud and spoke to Moses. Taking some of the Spirit that was in Moses, God bestowed it on the seventy elders whom Moses had gathered there; and as the Spirit came to rest on them, they were seized with prophesying, and did not stop.

Now two other elders, one named Eldad and the other Medad, were not in the gathering but had stayed behind in the camp. They had been summoned to the tent, but had not gone; yet the Spirit came to rest on them also, and they prophesied in the camp. When a youth came running to tell Moses, "Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp," Joshua, ben-Nun, who from youth had been Moses' aide, cried, "Moses, stop them!"

But Moses answered, "Are you jealous for my sake? If only all of God's people were prophets! If only the Lord would bestow the Spirit on them all!" Then Moses returned to the camp with the elders.

In the evening of that same day, the first day of the week, the doors were locked in the room where the disciples were, for fear of the Temple authorities.

Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Having said this, the savior showed them the marks of crucifixion.

The disciples were filled with joy when they saw Jesus, who said to them again, "Peace be with you. As Abba God sent me, so I'm sending you."

After saying this, Jesus breathed on them and said,

"Receive the Holy Spirit.

If you forgive anyone's sins, they are forgiven.

If you retain anyone's sins, they are retained."
